The Introduction of Safety Inquiry System 'ANPIC'

University of Fukui has introduced the safety inquiry system 'ANPIC' to confirm the students' and staffs' safety promptly and surely in the event of a large-scale disaster.

In emergency cases (for example, when an earthquake with a seismic intensity of 5 or greater occurs in Fukui Pref.), ANPIC sends out safety inquiry emails automatically to the accounts which have been registered in advance. And receivers of the emails can report each of their safety status, such as, if they are fine or not, if they can come to work or not, or can send some message with their own terminal in a simple way.

The system administrator will send out safety inquiry emails manually, in case that a large-scale disaster other than earthquake would occur and in case of disaster drills.
