SKU will process the study permit at the Ministry of Higher Education, Indonesia 3. Once it finished the applicant will get teleks visa and apply limited stay visa (ITAS) at Indonesia Embassy 4. After arrival at Banda Aceh, SKU will help students convert the ITAS into KITAS (Limited stay permit).
