Acceptance letter	Upon receiving the complete application file from the foreign students (international	
	office), the CCI will make a formal request for the Ministry of Education and Research	
	to issue an Acceptance Letter (usually taking up to max. 3 weeks to be issued).	
	The CCI will then send via e-mail and post office the copy and original acceptance	
	letter, together with the Certificate of Acceptance issued by UBB (max. 5 days for	
	Europe, max. 3 weeks for the Americas and Asia).
